Practising Worship

Sunday 9am - Contemporary

A service organised by our worship teams and the minister. It includes modern songs led by our music groups involving younger and older members of our church community.

Sunday 10.45am - Formal

A more traditional service organised by the minister with Hymns played on the pipe organ.

Practising Community Engagement

Playgroup – Friday mornings

Every Friday morning, during school term, children up to 4 years of age and their parents come together to socialise and explore a variety of play activities in a caring environment.

Biala

Staffed by a Co-ordinator, two day conveners and forty volunteers, the respite programme has been operating for over 30 years and is designed to give parents of children with additional needs (0 to 6 years) one day a week relief.

Ringwood Uniting Church Preschool

RUC runs a Preschool offering both 4-year-old and 3-year-old sessions run in partnership with Uniting Care Victoria and Tasmania. The Centre offers a high quality preschool program with strong connections with the church and connecting with our increasingly multicultural community.

Kids Hope (Prep – 6)

In a partnership between RUC and Great Ryrie Primary School, our mentors find ways to build a meaningful relationship with a child to make a positive difference in their life.

FRESH YOUTH THEATRE High School aged students – 2 Seasons per year - Every Tuesday during term

Fresh Youth Theatre is a program primarily focused on achieving social change through the use of applied theatre techniques. Applied Theatre is the use of theatre to accomplish nontheatrical objectives. Fresh uses a range of applied theatre practices to bring about societal development and personal growth.

Community Living Centre – CLC

The CLC Committee each semester offer a variety of community based activities for fun, fitness and friendship at Ringwood Uniting Church.

Walking Groups – Weekly on Wednesday mornings

We have two walking groups that walk locally and within the nearby foothills of the Dandenong Ranges and the valleys of the Yarra River.

RUC Bicycle User's Group – Saturday mornings

The group offers regular rides along Melbourne's bike paths and trails. For the longer rides, a full day is required.

Practising Hospitality

Friendship Centre – Mondays during school term

Our group of helpers and older members of the community who may have difficulty attending church meet weekly to share in fellowship and a lovely lunch together.

Fellowship Luncheon – 1st Sunday of the month

This is an opportunity to listen to a speaker, share a meal and have time together to talk and get to know each other better in a relaxed atmosphere.

Creative Friendships - 1st Saturday 11.30 – 3.00 pm

This is an enthusiastic group who love craft including sewing, quilting, knitting, scrapbooking and Christmas cards. A great way to spend Saturday with the opportunity to develop new friendships, and skills.

Music Appreciation

This is a group for all lovers of classical music. It meets once a quarter in the comfort of a member's home.

Practising Discipleship

Junior Church – 9am Service

Every Sunday during the school term the young kids from pre-school to grade 4 are engaged with activities during the second half of the 9am Service.

Talkback

Fortnightly, Grade 5 and 6 kids meet after the 9am service to share some food and discuss the message of the service from their perspective.

KONTROL

Kontrol is the Sunday morning discussion group for years 7 and up young people. It meets approximately every fortnight and we discuss a range of topics such as relationships, values, social justice issues, faith sharing, understanding of God, current affairs, Bible study, the church and what it stands for and how it works.

Café Conversation – 3rd Sunday of the month

Between the services, a new conversation each month as speakers inform us of where they have been, what they have done, who they work with or how we should be involved.
